"Conduct that has caused, or is likely to cause, harassment, alarm or distress to any person." The Anti-Social Behaviour, Crime & Policing Act 2014 (ASBCP 2014)

Making a call to the Emergency Services, <u>knowing</u> that there is no emergency. <u>This is a criminal offence.</u>






