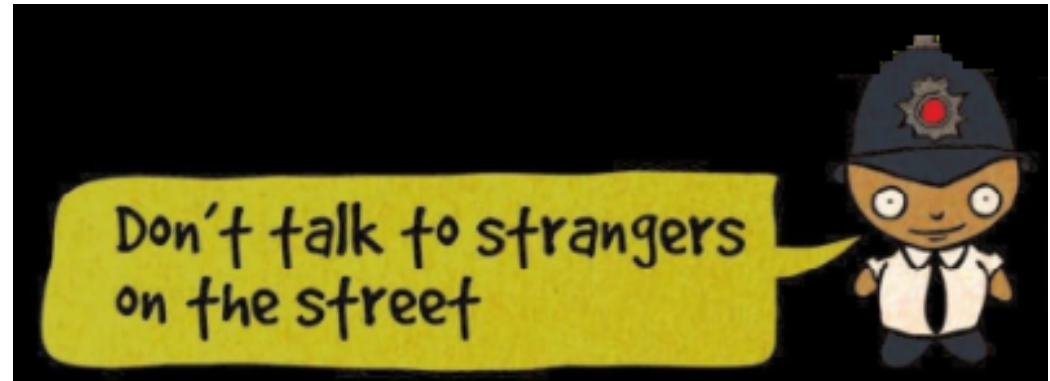

Always follow the firework code



- What is the Fireworks code?
- Do you know any of the safety rules?



FIREWORKS CODE



- Keep Fireworks in a closed box.
- Follow the instructions on each firework.
- Light all fireworks at arms length
- Stand well back.
- Never go back to a lit firework
- Never throw fireworks.
- Keep pets indoors





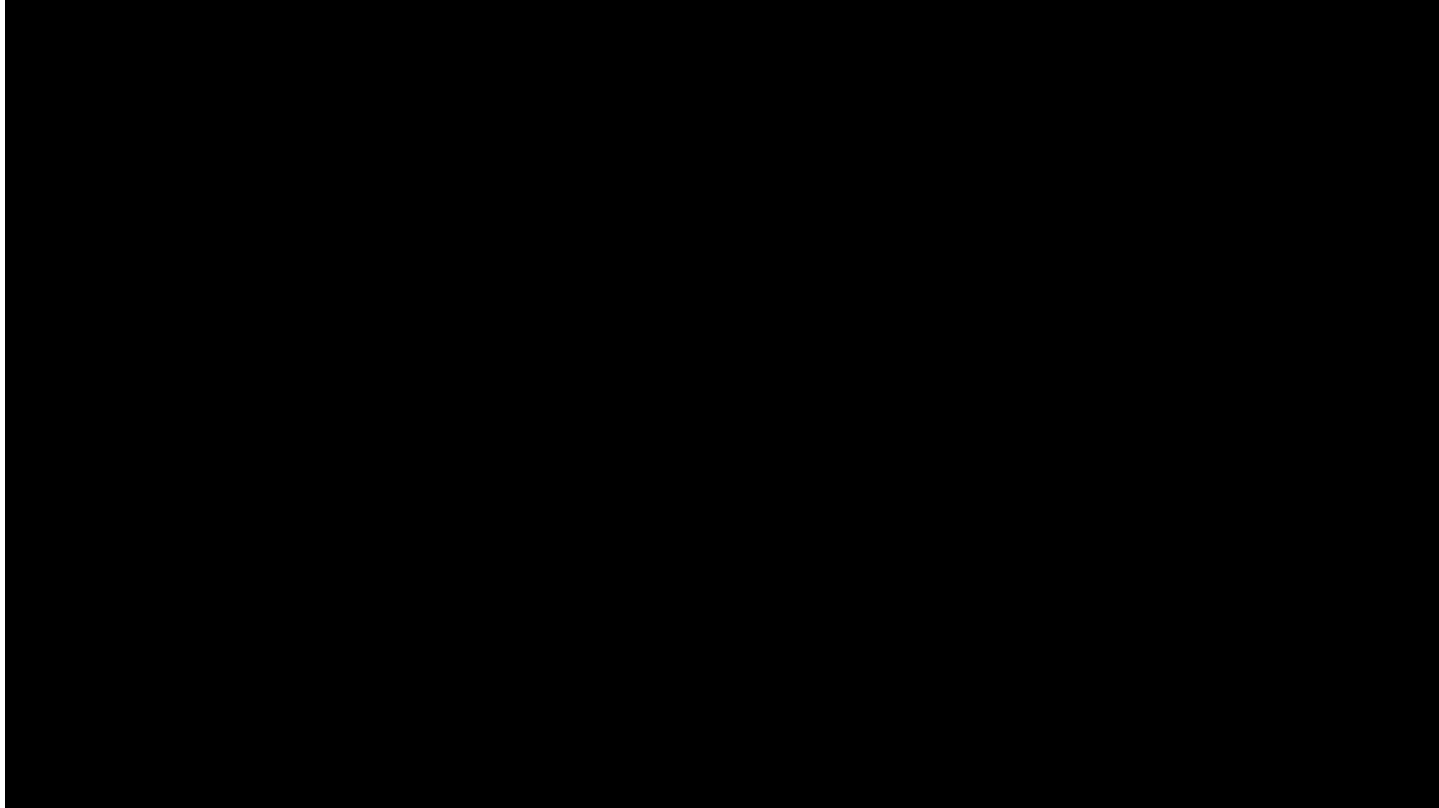
Making Your Community Safer

Sparklers

- Sparklers burn at 2,000 degrees.
- Hold Sparklers at Arms length.
- When Sparkler has finished put it in cold water.
- Never pick up a dropped Sparkler - it stays hot after it goes out.
- Make sure you protect your hands by always wearing gloves when holding Sparklers.



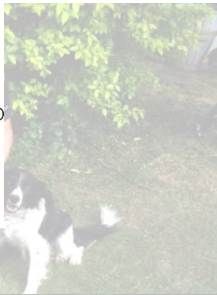
